199 Years and Counting: Now Spiceland in those days was not to be considered as a village, but at the center of a community extending for miles in every direction. The large proportion of the population were members of the Society of Friends who had emigrated from North Carolina and had settled there with their families. Probably nine tenths of the denizens of the town, and the surrounding farmers, were of that extraction. It was an exceptionally quiet sober, steadfast, home community, where strife and crime were unknown and severely reprobated.
